





[Reference 2] Transcript and Certificate of (scheduled) graduation

A. Applicants must submit a high school diploma and transcripts (freshmen), previous university's transcripts, and a Certificate of Enrollment (transfer) recognized by one of the following methods (with the exception of the official seal of the principal of one of the Korean International Schools authorized by the Minister of Education)

1. Obtaining Apostille stamps on documents (graduation & transcript of high school)

- ※ In case the student has attended or graduated from school(s) in a country that is a member to the Hague Convention; see Appendix #3 'Members to the Apostille Convention'
- 2. Obtaining certifications of documents (graduation & transcript of high school) from the Korean embassy or consular office in the country where the applicant's school is located; or from the Embassy of the country where the applicant's school is located in Korea
- 3. Only for applicants who receive(d) diploma or academic degree from Chinese school or universities
- X The verification at the website of the China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center (http://www.cdgdc.edu.cn) or China Higher-education Student Information(www.chsi.com.cn). It will take about 3~4 weeks
- Graduates(or graduates-to-be) from secondary vocational schools in China must submit the diploma and translations authenticated by (1) or (2)
- (1) The diploma and translations issued by a school, and authenticated by the province Education Department(省教育厅) and the Korean Embassy
- (2) The diploma and translations issued by the province Education Department(省教育厅) and authenticated by the Korean Embassy
- B. Admitted applicants, who submit the certificate of scheduled graduation(or scheduled course completion) at the time of application, must submit the additional certificate of graduation(or course completion) which is notarized in one of the aforementioned ways(1~3) in A, no later than the 26th of February, 2021 to the PNU International Office

[Reference 3] Certificate of Financial Support and Bank Balance Certificate

- **A. Bank Balance Certificate** in applicant's or parent's name verifying USD \$18,000 or more, or a certificate of remittance(The certificate should have been issued within the past 30 days) or a certificate of money transfer to Korea or Certificate of money exchange
- * Only Vietnam applicant should submit Korea bank balance certificate
- X Valid until the date indicated on the document, but we can only accept a document that has been issued within the past 6 months (Base date: Last day of submission of Documents)
- **B. Certificate of Financial Support [Form 3]** the sponsor is bank holder of Bank Balance Certificate, written and signed by a sponsor

4. Selection Method

□ Document Screening and Interview

X Admissions decisions are based on document screening and interview(by each department)

Document Screening

The Admissions Committee reviews a number of documents: records of past studies(such as GPA, Study Plan and Personal Statement, ect.)

** Applicants who are admitted only with documents will not need to do an interview, and they will be notified by each department

Interview

Face-to-face interview or zoom interview with department

- 1) Applicants in Korea: Face-to-face interview(will be conducted at each department's designated place)
- 2) Applicants Overseas: Phone or Zoom interview

NOTE on Interviews

- 1) Applicants in Korea must arrive at the designated place with the test identification slip and an ID card (passport, Alien Registration Card, and other documents) on the day of the interview
- 2) In principle, applicants overseas should be interviewed by phone or video conferencing, so it is important to write your exact phone number for the phone interview
- 3) If the applicant uses a substitute during the interview, admission will be canceled even if he or she has been admitted
- 4) The Department of Global Studies Conduct essay test and interviews in English



- Print out the test identification slip

 the application deadline(include application fee KRW ₩90,000 or USD \$80 and 2 ID photos(3x4cm)
