A. You can start with a Korean language course at PNU LEI. Once you complete the course, you may be eligible to apply for a degree program.

A. IEQAS stands for International Education Quality Assurance System. PNU has received official recognition from the government for 2024-2025, showing that we provide high-quality education and support for international students.

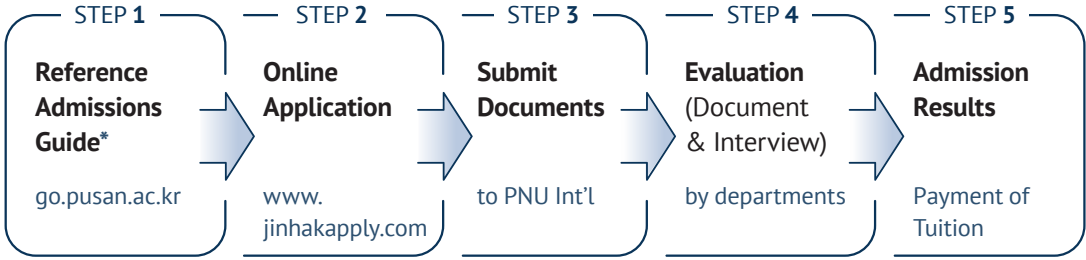

- **Nationality:** Applicant & parents must be non-Korean nationals
- **Education**
 - **UG:** High school graduate
 - **PG:** Bachelor's or Master's degree
- **Language:** TOPIK Level 3+ or completion of PNU LEI*(Level 3+)
*LEI: LANGUAGE EDUCATION INSTITUTE

TOPIK level requirement may vary by department. Check Admissions Guide.



Required Documents

1. Application Form
2. Final Degree Certificate & Transcript (Apostille/Consulate Authenticated)
3. Passport & Certificate of Family Relations
4. Language Proficiency Certificate
5. Bank Balance Certificate

All documents must be original.
