

B. Important Notes for Document Submission

1) Required Amount for the Bank Statement

→ The bank statement amount increases each year on January 1st, according to Ministry of Justice guidelines. For spring semester applicants, please submit an additional KRW 300,000 to meet the updated requirement.

2) If the Bank Statement is Not in Your Name

- → If the bank statement is under someone else's (parents) name, you must also submit the following documents via post
 - 1) Affidavit of Financial Support (Form attached)
 - 2) Official Family Certificate
- → Can be substituted with a scholarship certificate

3) Document Submission

→ Always ensure that **all submitted documents are in English** or are accompanied by a certified translation. This is crucial to avoid delays in the verification process and ensures your application proceeds smoothly.

9. Visa & Insurance

Visa

D-2-6 Visa

All students are responsible for applying for an exchange student visa (D-2-6) by submitting the Certificate of Admission to the Korean Consulate in their home country.

Insurance

All exchange students must have insurance during their stay in Korea. They are required to enroll in both the NHIS (National Health Insurance Service) for monthly payments and private insurance (either PNU Group Insurance or individually arranged insurance).
